Casey Township Cemetery Rules and Regulations

Effective May 12, 2012

All Rules and Regulations governing Casey Township Cemeteries enacted prior to the effective date of these rules and regulations are null and void.

Enforcement of Rules:

The Casey Township Cemetery Board is hereby empowered to enforce all Rules and Regulations and to exclude from the Cemetery any person violating the same. The Cemetery Board shall have charge of the grounds and buildings including the conduct of funerals, traffic, employees, lot owners and visitors and at all times shall have supervision and control of all persons in the Cemetery.

Definition of Terms

1. **Cemetery.** Cemetery is defined to include a burial park for earth interments, a mausoleum for vault or crypt interments, a crematory or crematorium for cinerary interments, or the combination of one or more of these.

2. **Corner Marker.** The term corner marker refers to a device used by a lot holder to mark the corners of a lot.

3. **Deed.** A deed to a burial lot is issued by Casey Township Cemeteries for the purpose of granting to the holder of the deed, to his or her family and heirs; and to any other specified individuals the right to be buried in a specific lot. Casey Township retains ownership of and responsibility for maintenance of the land itself.

4. **Cemetery Supervisor.** The term Cemetery Supervisor shall refer to the employee in charge of the Casey Township Cemeteries. This employee shall be appointed by the Casey Township Supervisor. This employee shall be in charge of the maintenance and upkeep of the cemeteries and shall be in charge of all burials in the cemeteries. The Cemetery Supervisor must report to the Township Supervisor.

5. **Cemetery Board.** The Cemetery Board shall consist of three board members appointed by the Casey Township Supervisor and approved by the Casey Township Board of Trustees. The Cemetery Board shall be responsible for adopting and enforcing all Rules and Regulations that govern the grounds and the roadways within the cemeteries. They shall meet once a month to approve all bills and conduct any necessary business.

6. **Grave.** This term shall apply to a space of sufficient size to accommodate one (1) adult full earth burial or one (1) cremation burial. One or more graves constitute a lot.

7. **Interment.** The term interment shall mean the permanent disposition of the remains or ashes of a deceased person by interment, entombment or burial.

8. **Lot.** This term shall apply to a numbered division of space within a cemetery consisting of one or more graves.

9. **Lot Holder.** The holder of a Deed to a burial lot.

10. **Marker.** The term marker means a monument which is flush with the ground.

11. **Monument.** The term monument shall include a marker, tablet, headstone, gravestone, tombstone, family stone, name stone, VA Marker, memorial or other similar structure which is flush with or extends above the surface of the ground.
